

PARK INFORMATION

PLEASE REGISTER AND SETTLE YOUR ACCOUNT ON ARRIVAL

SPEED LIMIT STRICTLY WALKING PACE – Bicycles & Vehicles

Office Hours – Daily 8:30am – 5pm

One car per cabin/site.

Powered Camp Sites – arrival 12pm with strictly **10am** departure.

1 car, 2 persons - additional charges will apply under your tariff for extra persons.

Maximum number of persons per site is 6.

Unpowered bush camping – arrival 12pm & departure 10am unless prior arrangement with management

Caravans/Camper Trailers - All drawbars must face the road in case of emergency evacuation.

Cabin Accommodation – will be available from 2pm on day of arrival with a strictly **10am** departure

Please leave your cabin clean and tidy to avoid additional cleaning charges.

Cancellations or Early Departures – please book carefully. If you change your mind after arrival - no refund. Please see our cancellation policy for further information.

Office – Ice, Water, Wood & kindling for sale during business hours

Fire Ban Season - is from 15th October to 15 April inclusive

Fires - on grass Powered sites are to be in a raised fire receptacle NOT on the grass,

Please do not place litter, glass or rubbish into the fire bins. No treated, painted or timber with metal fixtures/nails permitted.

Fires must be completely extinguished by 10pm or when retiring.

Wood – Collection or cutting of natural wood within the Caravan Park and campground is strictly prohibited

Bicycles – including E-Bikes are not permitted in cabins or camp kitchens

Charging E-Bike - Charger available behind camp kitchen in unpowered bush camping area. Charging batteries is NOT permitted in camp kitchen.

EV Charging Station - located behind Office. Cabin or site power is NOT to be used

Helmets – MUST be worn at all times when riding (warnings will be issued) this includes adults as well as children

Generators - are permitted in the unpowered bush camping area **ONLY**

Operation is **Strictly between 8:30am to 6pm** for charging purposes ONLY not to be in use all day.

Dogs – are permitted in the park but **NOT** in the National Park. Dogs must be on a lead at ALL times and are not permitted in public buildings including amenities.

Washing of dogs &/or their accessories is strictly forbidden. Doggy bags are available around the park for your convenience. Please refer to our Dog Friendly Policy

Laundry – both washing machine and dryers are available. The washing machine takes 4 x \$1 coins and 30 minutes per cycle, the dryer takes 4 x \$1 coins and 40min per cycle. Laundry powder and change are available from our office during normal office hours. Pegs & clothes lines are provided.

Rubbish – should be placed in the bins provided around the Park. Please keep your site clean and tidy.

Tennis/Basketball court fees are payable via an honour box located on the side of club house wall, rackets & balls are available from Office during business hours. Bicycles & skateboards are **NOT** permitted on courts

Behaviour – we ask that you respect your fellow residents' rights to peaceful enjoyment of the park. Music and noise should be kept to a minimum and cease at 10pm. Drunkenness, offensive behaviour and rowdy parties will not be tolerated. You are responsible for those in your company. Management has the right to terminate occupancy for any rule breach or undesirable conduct.

Responsibility – all persons enter the park at their own risk and are totally responsible for their own property and motor vehicles.
